BRITISH PRIME MINISTER DEFIES SUPREME COURT AND PLEDGES TO CONTINUE THE "DEPORTATION OF ASYLUM SEEKERS TO RWANDA" PLAN

In a direct challenge to judicial authority, the British government has pledged to proceed with its plan to send migrants to Rwanda. A committee of five judges in the highest court in the United Kingdom unanimously upheld the decision of the appellate judges to reject the government's appeal to send asylum seekers to Rwanda, citing a real risk of mistreatment and stating that the policy does not align with the UK's international commitments. This was considered a significant blow to British Prime Minister Rishi Sunak by government opposition.

The judges stated in their ruling, "We have concluded that the Court of Appeal was entitled to find tangible grounds for believing that sending asylum seekers to Rwanda may expose them to a real risk of ill-treatment." However, hours after this judgment, the government announced that it would proceed with finalizing a "new treaty" with Rwanda to address these concerns.

Sunak pointed out that he would introduce "emergency legislation" to Parliament to classify Rwanda as a safe country to end the "whirlwind" of legal challenges. He stated, "I will not allow a foreign court to prevent these flights," expressing hope to send the first batch of migrants to Rwanda "as planned next spring."

If the European Court of Human Rights chooses to "intervene in opposition to the explicit wishes of Parliament," Sunak stated that he is prepared to do what is necessary to cancel the flights. He told Parliament, "If it becomes apparent that our domestic legal frameworks or international agreements continue to thwart plans at this stage, I am prepared to change our laws and reconsider these international relationships."

The "Migration and Economic Development Partnership" stipulates that anyone engaging in what the government describes as "dangerous or illegal journeys, such as on small boats or trucks" towards the United Kingdom should be sent to Rwanda. Critics, however, condemn the Rwanda plan as cruel, costly, and difficult to implement. Sunak's government had previously passed legislation in July prohibiting those arriving "illegally" from applying for asylum but depended on finding third countries to which they could be sent. Speculation now suggests that the government may seek agreements with other countries.

JABR: ECONOMIC CRISES AND LIMITED JOB OPPORTUNITIES CONSTITUTE FERTILE GROUND FOR ILLEGAL MIGRATION

Dr. Ahmed Al-Ansari, the Governor of Fayoum, and Ambassador Naela Gabr, the head of the National Coordinating Committee for Combating and Preventing Illegal Migration and Human Trafficking, held a meeting with the heads of centers and cities, as well as representatives from the Ministries of Education, Health, Youth and Sports, Manpower, Social Solidarity, representatives of the National Women's Council, the Child Protection Unit in the governorate, the Human Rights Unit, the Small and Micro Enterprises Development Agency, and other executive bodies in the governorate. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss mechanisms and procedures for achieving women's economic empowerment, community development, and combating illegal migration.

During the meeting, Al-Ansari and Gabr discussed areas of mutual cooperation in addressing illegal migration, expanding awareness programs, and student competitions in schools to confront this issue. The meeting was attended by Senator Walid Howidi and Laila Taha Qassem, the head of the National Women's Council branch in Fayoum.

Al-Ansari emphasized the significant efforts made by the state to combat illegal migration through a national working team comprising executive bodies, civil society organizations, and appreciated the political leadership's clear vision and ability to quickly resolve problems. He affirmed the governorate's commitment to supporting civil society efforts in achieving development plans.

The governor highlighted ongoing development projects in the governorate, aiming to provide real job opportunities for youth to reduce illegal migration. He also mentioned the "Decent Life" presidential initiative, which focuses on human development, finding fundamental solutions to chronic problems in rural areas, and improving services and infrastructure.

In her remarks, Ambassador Gabr expressed gratitude to the governor for his warm welcome and full support of the committee's efforts in the governorate. She mentioned ongoing achievements in various sectors and emphasized the importance of regular visits to Fayoum due to its promising potential.

Gabr noted that Fayoum is targeted for training within a comprehensive system of traditions, values, and ethical principles promoted by various religions. She highlighted the committee's efforts in organizing awareness campaigns on the risks of illegal migration and human trafficking, as well as providing alternative solutions and decent job opportunities.

Regarding efforts to raise awareness among youth and children about the dangers of illegal migration, Ambassador Gabr mentioned school campaigns and significant collaboration with the Ministry of Education. She highlighted a recent artistic competition launched by the committee, the Ministry of Education, and the International Organization for Migration on the risks of illegal migration. Additionally, she emphasized the importance of economic empowerment for women and children's rights and protection.

The governor and the head of the committee underscored the impact of economic crises and limited job opportunities as fertile ground for illegal migration. They emphasized the need to enhance development as the fundamental pillar that creates employment opportunities and provides new prospects for youth seeking a better life. The committee expressed its commitment to conducting informative campaigns on the risks of illegal migration and collaborating with government agencies and civil society organizations.

In conclusion, the meeting highlighted the joint efforts to combat illegal migration, create economic opportunities, and support community development initiatives. Both parties expressed their commitment to ongoing cooperation in raising awareness and implementing projects that contribute to reducing the phenomenon of illegal migration.

THE ARREST OF THREE MOROCCANS FOR MANUFACTURING "RUBBER MIGRATION BOATS"



The anti-gang unit in the Moroccan city of Laayoune has arrested three individuals on charges of being associated with criminal enterprises due to their involvement in the manufacturing of rubber boats used in illegal migration operations across the sea. Security authorities stated that the arrests took place in two operations. The first operation's investigative procedures led to the apprehension of two individuals caught in the act of illegally manufacturing rubber boats. Additionally, a rubber boat and equipment used in the production of these boats, utilized in illegal migration operations, were seized.

In the second operation, search and inspection measures resulted in the arrest of a third person and the confiscation of two rubber boats, one of which was in the manufacturing stage. Equipment and supplies used in the production and preparation of rubber boats were also seized. The three suspects are undergoing judicial investigation to uncover any possible connections of these criminal activities to networks involved in illegal migration and human trafficking.

Trump describes "illegal immigrants" as "invaders" and pledges the largest internal deportation operation after returning to the White House for a second term.

Donald Trump has successfully gained the endorsement of the governor of the state of Texas in the 2024 presidential elections, following his visit to the state, which is considered the closest to the US-Mexico border and has witnessed an increase in the numbers of illegal immigrants. Trump relies on his anti-immigrant rhetoric and strict immigration policy proposals in his electoral strategy.

The governor of Texas stated, "We need Trump back as the President of the United States." Trump, in turn, criticized the current president, Joe Biden, saying, "The United States now has insecure borders." During his election campaign, the former president intensified his rhetoric, preparing for the "largest internal deportation operation in American history" if he wins the White House again next year. He described illegal immigrants as "poisoning the blood of our country" and referred to them as "invaders," emphasizing the urgent need to stop the invasion at the southern border to preserve national security.

Trump plans to expand widely the strict immigration policies of his administration, which would restrict both legal and illegal immigration, if elected for a second term. The plans include rounding up illegal immigrants already in the United States and placing them in detention camps awaiting deportation.

Such a proposal would necessitate the construction of large camps to house immigrants awaiting deportation and would involve federal and local law enforcement authorities in arresting illegal immigrants across the country.

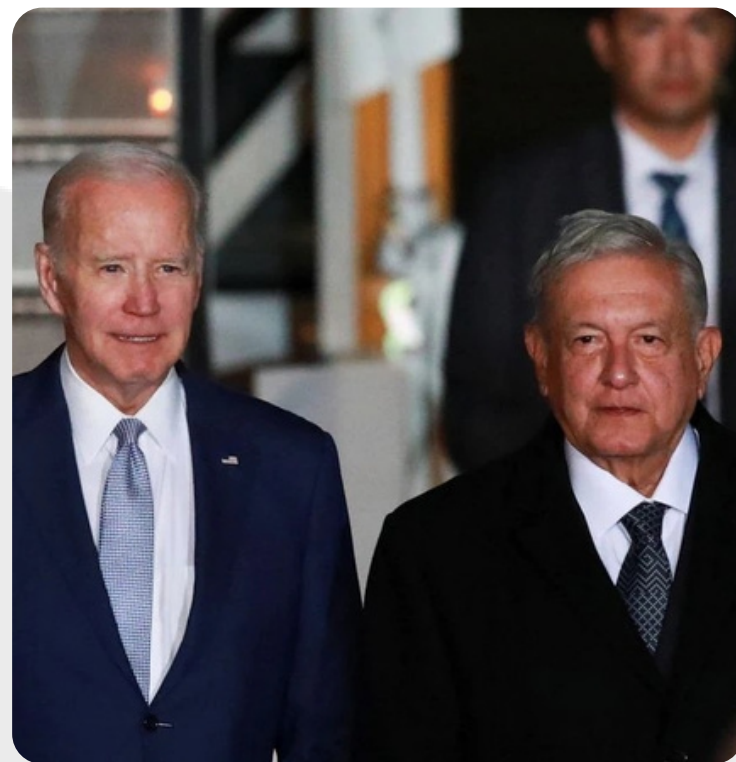
Biden campaign officials criticized Trump's policies, stating, "Donald Trump is persecuting immigrants, our rights, our safety, and our democracy," describing Trump's visit to the US-Mexico border and immigration-related policies as "inhumane" and "harsh."

AND HE DESCRIBES BIDEN AS AN "EXCEPTIONAL PRESIDENT."

President Biden discussed immigration issues with his Mexican counterpart, Andrés Manuel López Obrador, in San Francisco before the conclusion of a major economic summit for Pacific Rim countries. Biden affirmed that he couldn't have a "better partner" than Mexico in addressing current challenges. He thanked López Obrador for assisting in "confronting the challenge" posed by the immigration crisis at the border, acknowledging that it's not an easy task. The two leaders discussed the close economic ties between their countries, particularly in the industrial production supply chains, and the fight against fentanyl trafficking, a potent substance responsible for numerous deaths annually in the United States due to overdose. López Obrador described the relationship between the two nations as "excellent" and praised his counterpart as an "exceptional president" and a man of conviction. The White House stated that Biden and López Obrador specifically decided to "work together to respond to what Nicaragua and private entities are doing to encourage illegal migration, enhance police and judicial cooperation to combat human trafficking, drugs, and weapons." The United States also seeks ways to take legal action against these activities, and Biden aims to win a second term while facing repeated attacks from political opponents regarding his immigration policy. Most immigrants seeking entry to the United States come from Ecuador, Colombia, Haiti, Cuba, Venezuela, Guatemala, and Honduras. Biden emphasizes a "humane" approach to the issue while making decisions that clearly restrict access to U.S. soil. Despite the Mexican president describing the continued construction of a barrier between the U.S. and Mexico as a "step back," President Biden reaffirmed his legal commitment to executing the project initiated by his predecessor, Donald Trump, while stressing the importance of collaboration with Mexico in dealing with the large numbers of incoming migrants at the border. In a related context, the Mexican president expressed gratitude to his U.S. counterpart for establishing legal migration channels.



500 ASYLUM SEEKERS IN FINLAND

Finland says that Russian border guards are likely to be "strongly involved" in the influx of migrants at the border.

The Finnish Border Guard stated in a release that Russian authorities are likely significantly involved in transporting migrants to two border crossings that remain open. This comes as Finland seeks to reduce the flow of migrants from Russia.

Over 500 asylum seekers, mostly from Yemen, Somalia, Syria, and Iraq, have arrived in Finland, an eastern border point of the European Union, through Russia in a sudden increase over the past two weeks. This prompted Helsinki to close half of its border crossings and shut down the borders. Moscow is accused of transporting migrants to its borders, a charge that it denies. Finland and Russia had jointly warned against illegal border crossings.

Despite the strict measures, the Finnish Border Guard recently banned one-way bicycle traffic, but Russia continues to allow migrants to cross with bicycles. The city of Salla received asylum requests from migrants after Finland closed four border stations and erected barriers to prevent illegal crossings.

Captain Jukka Kinnunen stated that at the Vaarti border crossing, 16 migrants from Syria and Somalia arrived in recent days, with more expected despite the temperature dropping to 10 degrees Celsius below zero and icy winds in the region.



47 THOUSAND ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS HAVE ARRIVED IN ITALY SINCE THE BEGINNING OF 2023



According to recent data from the Italian Ministry of Interior, 47,300 illegal immigrants have arrived from Libya since the beginning of the year 2023.

Official figures show that around 30,000 of these migrants departed from the western region, while the remaining number arrived from the eastern region.

Italy received 95,000 migrants through the Tunisian route, averaging 300 migrants per day. This marks a significant increase compared to 2022 when only 32,000 migrants arrived.

Tunisia foils 30 attempts of illegal migration

The Tunisian authorities have thwarted 30 attempts of illegal migration across maritime borders, rescuing 709 illegal migrants who were attempting to cross towards European shores.

The official spokesperson for the Tunisian National Guard stated that 34 boats and vessels were seized, and an additional 5 individuals were apprehended, as their involvement in organizing illegal migration operations was confirmed. Legal procedures will be taken against those detained.



Within the framework of the "Share Your Voice" initiative, the Minister of Migration begins her foreign tours with visits to Saudi Arabia and the United Arab Emirates. The visit aims to reaffirm the constitutional rights of Egyptians and promote investment in Egypt.

IN THE UNITED ARAB EMIRATES, AMBASSADOR SOHA GENDI, MINISTER OF EMIGRATION, MET WITH THE CONSUL GENERAL OF EGYPT IN DUBAI AND THE NORTHERN EMIRATES, AMBASSADOR ASHRAF EL-DEEB. THE MINISTER ENGAGED WITH THE EGYPTIAN COMMUNITY, WHICH IS CONSIDERED IMPORTANT AND DISTINGUISHED IN VARIOUS FIELDS. ADDITIONALLY, THE MINISTER EXPRESSED GRATITUDE TO THE EGYPTIANS PRESENT FOR DISCUSSING WAYS TO SUPPORT THE NATIONAL ECONOMY, EMPHASIZING THE LEADERSHIP'S INTEREST IN INVESTMENT WITH THE LAUNCH OF THE SUPREME INVESTMENT COUNCIL UNDER THE PRESIDENCY OF PRESIDENT ABDEL FATTAH EL-SISI. VARIOUS LEGISLATIVE AMENDMENTS AND DECISIONS HAVE BEEN MADE TO ATTRACT INVESTORS.

EGYPT IS ACTIVELY ADDRESSING CLIMATE CHANGE, HOSTING COP27, AND WELCOMING RESEARCHERS AND EXPERTS TO SHARE EXPERIENCES IN DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION, CLEAN AND SUSTAINABLE ENERGY, AND ACHIEVING "ZERO EMISSIONS." THE MINISTER EMPHASIZED THAT EGYPTIANS ABROAD HAVE A NATIONAL DUTY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE UPCOMING PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS FOR THE COUNTRY'S DEVELOPMENT AND ACHIEVEMENTS TO CONTINUE.

SHE HIGHLIGHTED EGYPT'S ABUNDANT NATURAL RESOURCES, THE SUEZ CANAL AS A VITAL GLOBAL TRADE ROUTE, AND SKILLED YOUNG LABOR SOUGHT AFTER GLOBALLY. EGYPT IS DETERMINED TO PROVIDE MORE OPPORTUNITIES FOR NATIONAL AND PRIVATE SECTOR INVESTMENTS. THE GOVERNMENT'S DIVESTMENT FROM SEVERAL STATE-OWNED COMPANIES AIMS TO ATTRACT MORE INVESTMENTS AND INJECT MORE HARD CURRENCY INTO THE NATIONAL ECONOMY, FOCUSING ON PROFITABLE AND SUCCESSFUL PROJECTS. THE MINISTER STRESSED THE EXCEPTIONAL OPPORTUNITIES THAT EGYPTIAN INVESTORS ABROAD SHOULD EXPLOIT AND BENEFIT FROM.

THE MINISTER PRESENTED AN OVERVIEW OF THE ECONOMIC AND FINANCIAL REFORMS UNDERTAKEN BY THE STATE, ANTICIPATING IMPROVED ECONOMIC PERFORMANCE IN 2024. SHE DISCUSSED VARIOUS INCENTIVES OFFERED BY THE GOVERNMENT TO INVESTORS, ESPECIALLY EGYPTIANS ABROAD. SHE APPRECIATED THE PROPOSAL FOR DONATIONS FROM EGYPTIANS ABROAD TO SUPPORT HUMANITARIAN INITIATIVES IN EGYPT AND ENDORSED THE MINISTRY OF EMIGRATION'S INITIATIVE FOR AN ELECTRONIC APPLICATION SERVING DOCTORS AMONG EGYPTIANS ABROAD WILLING TO PRACTICE THEIR PROFESSION IN EGYPT DURING THEIR VACATIONS. THE MINISTER PRAISED THE COMMITMENT OF EGYPTIAN DOCTORS ABROAD TO PROVIDING SERVICES IN EGYPT, EMPHASIZING THE NEED FOR COLLABORATION TO ACHIEVE SUCCESS.

IN A RELATED CONTEXT, THE MINISTER REVIEWED SOME OF THE INCENTIVES IMPLEMENTED BY THE MINISTRY OF EMIGRATION FOR EGYPTIANS ABROAD SINCE ASSUMING OFFICE IN AUGUST 2022. THESE INCLUDE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE "EGYPTIANS ABROAD FOR INVESTMENT" COMPANY, INDIRECT REMITTANCE MECHANISMS, HIGH-YIELD SAVINGS CERTIFICATES, DOLLAR-DENOMINATED PENSIONS, THE REACTIVATION OF THE "EGYPTIANS ABROAD CARS" INITIATIVE, PROVIDING AIRFARE FOR EGYPTIAN FAMILIES ABROAD, OFFERING HOUSING UNITS AND PLOTS OF LAND, AND COORDINATION WITH THE MINISTRIES OF DEFENSE AND FOREIGN AFFAIRS FOR A CONSCRIPTION SETTLEMENT INITIATIVE FOR EGYPTIANS ABROAD, INCLUDING INSURANCE AND PENSIONS. THE MINISTER HIGHLIGHTED VARIOUS ALTERNATIVE MECHANISMS FOR SERVICES TO EGYPTIANS IN HARD CURRENCY.

MINISTER OF EMIGRATION ALSO POINTED OUT THE LAUNCH OF THE CAMPAIGN "INVESTORS ABROAD RESPOND: WHY INVEST IN EGYPT." THE CAMPAIGN AIMS TO HIGHLIGHT THE DISTINCTIVE FEATURES OF THE EGYPTIAN MARKET, THE PROMISING INVESTMENT OPPORTUNITIES ACROSS VARIOUS SECTORS AMID ONGOING DEVELOPMENT EFFORTS, AND THE PROVISION OF TOP-NOTCH INFRASTRUCTURE. THE CAMPAIGN INCLUDES SHORT VIDEOS WHERE EGYPTIAN EXPERTS ABROAD SHARE THEIR TESTIMONIALS ABOUT INVESTING IN EGYPT.

THE MINISTER HIGHLIGHTED THE REGULAR VIRTUAL MEETINGS SHE ORGANIZES WITH EGYPTIAN INVESTORS ABROAD TO KEEP THEM INFORMED ABOUT ALL INVESTMENT OPPORTUNITIES IN THE COUNTRY. THESE MEETINGS FOCUS ON PROJECTS WITHIN EGYPT TO ENSURE THAT EGYPTIAN INVESTORS ABROAD HAVE EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES TO BENEFIT AND COMPETE FOR OWNERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT. THE MINISTER EMPHASIZED THE DETAILED PRESENTATIONS BY SENIOR OFFICIALS, MINISTERS, AND THE SECRETARY-GENERAL OF THE SOVEREIGN FUND DURING THESE MEETINGS, RESULTING IN AGREEMENTS AND DEALS THAT MAY NOT HAVE BEEN POSSIBLE WITHOUT UNDERSTANDING THEIR PRIORITIES FOR EGYPT.

AMBASSADOR SOHA GENDI CONFIRMED THAT, IN RESPONSE TO THE REQUESTS OF EGYPTIANS ABROAD, THE CONDITIONS OF HOUSING INITIATIVES FOR EGYPTIANS ABROAD HAVE BEEN ADJUSTED, AS WELL AS AMENDMENTS TO INSURANCE LAWS. ALL THESE SERVICES WILL BE INCORPORATED INTO THE UPCOMING ELECTRONIC APPLICATION, CURRENTLY UNDER DEVELOPMENT IN COLLABORATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY, AIMING TO BE A COMPREHENSIVE PLATFORM FOR ALL SERVICES PROVIDED TO EGYPTIANS ABROAD.

THE MINISTER EMPHASIZED THE IMPORTANCE OF EGYPTIANS ABROAD TRANSFERRING THEIR FUNDS THROUGH OFFICIAL CHANNELS TO PREVENT FRAUD AND TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE ELIMINATION OF TRANSFER FEES OFFERED BY THE BANK OF EGYPT.

SHE REITERATED THE MINISTRY OF EMIGRATION'S ROLE AS THE REPRESENTATIVE OF EGYPTIANS ABROAD WITHIN THE EGYPTIAN STATE INSTITUTIONS, EXPRESSING THE MINISTRY'S FULL AND CONTINUOUS READINESS TO MEET THE NEEDS AND DESIRES OF EGYPTIANS ABROAD WITHOUT FATIGUE OR BOREDOM.
